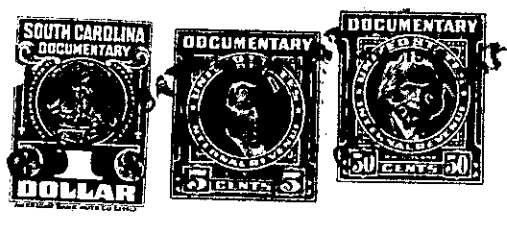

BEGINNING at a point in the middle of topsoiled road, said point being 111.7 feet north of the Moorehead line, and running thence S. 80.48 W. 17 feet to an iron pin on the side of said road; thence in a straight line, Six Hundred Seventy Nine (679) feet, to a branch; thence along said branch, N. 12.30 W. 129 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 82-45 E. 707 feet to the center of said topsoiled road; thence practically due South, One Hundred Five (105) feet, to the point of beginning. This being a portion of the property shown on a revised plat of the estate of J. H. Ballenger, made May 1933. And this is the same property conveyed to Mary M.
