

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot No. 29 on a Plat of property of Marsmen, Inc., recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "P", page 5, and having according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of Fisher Drive, joint corner of lots Nos. 28 and 29, and running thence with line of lot No. 28, N. 9-12 W., 421 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 76-13 E., 100.3 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots Nos. 29 and 30; thence with line of lot No. 30, S. 9-12 E., 429 feet to an iron pin in center of Fisher Drive; thence with Fisher Drive, S. 80-48 W., 100 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
