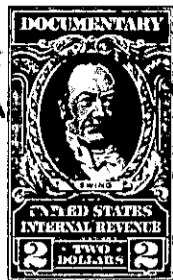

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said .. James Powell, his heirs and assigns, .. forever:

All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate lying and being on the Northeast side of Mauldin Street and on the Northwest side of Patton Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 2 of Block H, on Plat of Furman Investment Company, revised by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, July 1923, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book "F", Pages 159 and 160, and having according to said Plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Patton Street, said pin being at the point where the Northeast side of Mauldin Street intersects with the Northwest side of Patton Street, and running thence along the Northwest side of Patton Street, N. 65-15 E. 163.25 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 38-15 W. 77.32 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 4, S. 52-20 W. 158.36 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Mauldin Street; thence along the Northeast side of Mauldin Street, S. 37-40 E. 40 feet to the beginning corner.

The Grantee is to pay 1947 taxes.
