of South Carolina containing 7.22 acres, and having according to a survey made by T. T. Dill in July 1947, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Parker Road at joint corner of Edwin B. Wynn tract and running thence with the line of said land, N. 56 E. 545.2 feet to iron pin in old road; thence S. 54-37 E. 538.5 feet to iron pin; thence S. 60 W. 803.5 feet to iron pin on Parker Road; thence with Parker Road, N. 26-32 W. 431.4 feet to the beginning corner.

ALSO, All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 2.96 acres, and having according to a survey made by T. T. Dill in July 1947, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Northeast corner of the 8.50 acres of land conveyed to Edwin B. Wynn and Fred W. Wynn, and running thence with the line of said land, S. 58 W. 747 feet to Hickory; thence N. 32 W. 199 feet to iron pin; thence N. 66 E. 860 feet to iron pin; thence S. 10 E. 133 feet to the point of beginning.

This deed is executed by E. Inman, Master, pursuant to a Decree of the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County in the case of Truly Howard Wynn, et al vs. Robert Wynn Putman, he having been directed to convey the undivided interest of Robert Wynn Putman.
