

This property is the same shown on the Greenville City Block Book at Page 1, Section 6, Lot 10 and is the identical property conveyed by Marguerite C. Miller to Ruth Carrie Cannon on April 27, 1936, by deed recorded in Vol. 184 at Page 307 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

SECOND: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the North side of Davis Street, in the City of Greenville, shown as Lot No. 12 on plat of property of A.B. Davis made by W. A. Hudson, June 25, 1906, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A" at Page 183, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Davis Street, 100 feet East of Clairmont Street, corner of Lot No. 11, and running thence with the line of said lot N. $35\frac{1}{2}$ E. 100 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 7; thence with the line of said lot S. 55 E. 50 feet to corner of Lot No. 13; thence with the line of said lot S. $35\frac{1}{2}$ W. 100 feet to Davis Street; thence with the Northern side of Davis Street N. 55 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is shown on the Greenville City Block Book at Page 42, Section 1, Lot 17, and is the identical property conveyed by J. E. Gosnell to Mertie Naomi Cannon on Sept. 19, 1941, by deed recorded in Vol. 237 at Page 276 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

THIRD: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the southwest side of the Laurens Road about two miles southeast of Greenville County Court House, and being known and described as lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 35, 36 and 37, Block A, of sub-division known as Victory Heights, according to plat made by C. C. Jones, March 1942, recorded in the office of R.M.C. in and for Greenville County in Plat Book K, Pages 126 and 127, reference to which is craved for metes and bounds.

This property is shown on the Greenville County Block Book at Page 266, Section 1, Lots 1 A to 1 F and is the same conveyed by Sophie McA. Stokes and others to J. H. Cannon, V. L. Cannon and J. C. Cannon, as partners in business under the firm name of Piedmont Furniture and Store Fixture Co. on July 8, 1942, by deed recorded in Vol. 246 at Page 169 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.

FOURTH: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the east side of the Saluda River and on the west side of Farris Bridge Road about six miles from Greenville Court House and being what remains of a tract of land conveyed to R. E. Griffin by C. L. Willimon by deed dated March 28, 1938, recorded in Book 202, page 438. The identical lot here conveyed begins on the west bank of Farris Bridge Road at corner of a lot of land previously conveyed by R. E. Griffin to McNab and runs thence in a northwesterly direction about 225 ft. to the Saluda River; thence along Saluda River in a generally northeasterly direction 25 feet more or less to corner of a lot previously conveyed by R. E. Griffin to R. C. Huff; thence along Huff's line which is marked by a fence in
