All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots Nos. 17 and 19, Block F, of subdivision known as Park Place as shown on plat recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, Page 119, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of First Avenue (now known as New Buncombe Road) which point is 50 feet south of the southwest intersection of said First Avenue and 2nd Street, and running thence along the dividing line of Lots Nos. 19 and 21, a distance of 150 feet to a ten foot alley at the rear corner of said lots; thence in a southerly direction along said alley 100 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 17; thence in an easterly direction along the dividing line of Lots Nos. 15 and 17, 150 feet to a point on the western side of First Avenue (now New Buncombe Road); thence along the west side of said First Avenue in a northerly direction 100 feet to the beginning corner.
