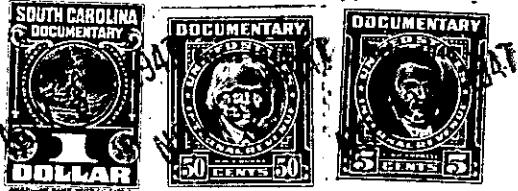

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Delora McCury Ballew.....

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred fifty and no/100
..(\$450.00)..... Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by James Edwin Camp
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said..... James Edwin Camp, his heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina on the waters of Vaughan Creek, and the waters
of Pacolet River, adjoining the lands of Sarah Blackwell,
Revan and Ballew, and others:

BEGINNING at a stone, Sara Blackwells corner and on the Revan line
and runnin then S. 88 1/2 deg. W 493 feet to an iron pin: then N.
21 1/2 deg. W (1 deg. va) 840 feet to a stone (Weatherbes and Ballews
line) then N. 66 deg. E. 68 ft. to a point, S. 24 deg. E 295 ft.
to a blackgum: then S. 73 1/2 deg. E 142 ft. to a red oak: ther N. 32 1/2
deg. E. 414 ft. to an iron pin (the 3 proceeding calls following
the coundaries of the property of Delora McCur Ballew): then S.
37 de. E. 550 ft. to a stone in the Blackwell line: then S. 10 1/2
deg. W. 417 ft. along the Blackwell line to the point of BEGINNING:
