BEGINNING at a stake at the intersection of Cooley's Bridge Road with Augusta Road; thence S. 32 W. 8.08 to a stake 3x in Cooley's Bridge Road; thence S. 75 E. 4.50 along property of the estate of King Chandler; thence N. 33½ E. 6 to a stake 3xn on the West side of the Augusta Road; thence N. 49 W. 4.50 up the Augusta Road to a stake 3xn, the beginning corner.
