

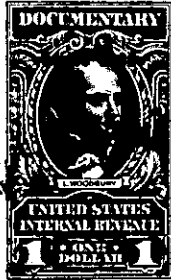

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Charles E. Butler

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the west side of county road by C.C.C. dam on Middle Beaverdam Creek and bounded by lands of Lucia Rose Plumblee and other lands of Lillie Noble Plumblee, being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west bank of road and a corner of land of grantor and Ellis peach orchard and running thence S. 18-15 E. 88.0 feet to stake at white oak; thence S. 79-38 W. 264.0 feet to stake; thence N. 18-15 W. 53.5 feet to iron pin, corner of 10 acre tract of Lucia Rose Plumblee; thence N. 73-00 E. 263.0 feet to beginning, containing 0.43 acres, more or less, being the same conveyed to the grantor herein by Lillie Noable Plumblee by deed dated February 7, 1947, recorded in R. M. C. Office on September 3, 1947.

Also that tract of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, described as follows:

Beginning on an iron pin on the Ellis corner and running thence with the Ellis line S. 18-15 E. 1660 feet to iron pin on said line; thence S. 73 W. 263 feet to stake; thence N. 18-15 W. 1660 feet to point in the road leading from Tigerville to Greenville; thence up said road N. 73 E. 263 feet to iron pin, the beginning corner, containing 10 acres, more or less, joined by lands of Ellis and Lillie A. Plumblee. This is a part of the J. J. Noble land, said tract conveyed to the grantor herein by Lillie A. Plumblee by deed dated December 29, 1944.
