

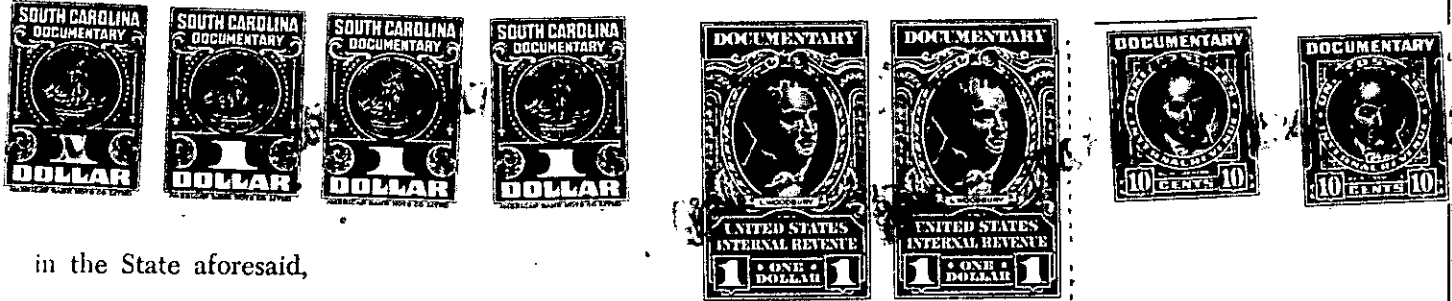

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, in School District 7-A, in the community known as Batesville and on the Southwest side of Harris Street, and having such shape, metes and bounds as delineated on the plat of B. S. H. Harris recorded in Plat Book "P", at page 147, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, as Lot No. 19, and having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Harris Street, and running thence S. 42-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 47-30 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 42-30 E. 209.9 feet to iron pin on the Southwest side of Harris Street; thence with South side of Harris Street, N. 40-45 W. 85 feet to iron pin; thence, continuing with Harris Street, N. 47-30 W. 15.2 feet to the beginning corner, reference to said plat is hereby made for a full, complete, and better description of the location, and boundaries.
