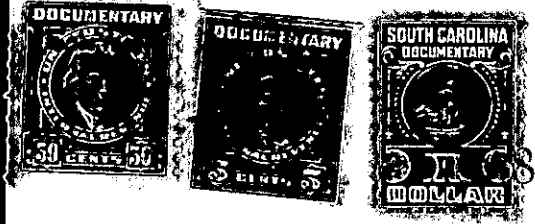

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ellis P. Rollins, and his Heirs and
Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, lying on the north side of the Brushy Creek
Road, between said Road and the right of way of the Southern Railway,
near the City of Greer, and Southwest therefrom, being all of Lots
11, 12, and 14 on plat of property made for Mrs. Grace W. Schilleter
by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated September 29, 1947, to be herewith
recorded, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake at the intersection of two new streets,
being the southeastern corner of Lot No. 11, and runs thence with
the north side of new 30 foot street S. 73.38 W. 300 feet to a
stake, joint corner of Lots 14 and 15; thence with the common line
of Lots 14 and 15 N. 16 W. 150 feet to a stake on the right of way
of the Southern Railway; thence with the right of way of said railway
N. 73.38 E. 50 feet to a stake; thence S. 16 E. 50 feet to a stake;
joint corner of Lots 12 and 13; thence with the common line of these
lots N. 73.38 E. 290 feet to a stake on the west side of new street;
thence with the west side thereof S. 5.45 W. 108 feet to the
beginning corner.
