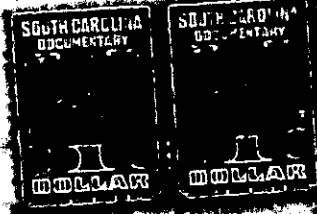

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Melvin Thomas

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred - - - - - Dollars
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Jack Thomas

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jack Thomas his Heirs and Assigns
forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina and containing 120 acres, more or less, situated
on waters of Reedy River, on the east side of Martin's creek, being
all the tract of 237.6 acres conveyed to John M. Anderson by W. P.
Nesbit by deed dated December 15, 1916, recorded in the Office of
the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book 41, at page 548, metes
and bounds being there fully given and said description being here
incorporated as a part of the description of this deed, less, however,
117.8 acres, more or less, conveyed by the said John M. Anderson to
Mary J. Smith by deed dated February 15, 1925, recorded in said Office
in Book 106, at page 414, description of said 117.8 acres by metes
and bounds being therein fully given. Bounded by lands of J. B.
Tumblin, Herman Tollison, other lands of the Grantor and others.
This being the same tract of land conveyed to me by deed of B. C.
Givens on the 13th day of November 1945 and being of record in
said R. M. C. Office in Book 283, at page 54.
