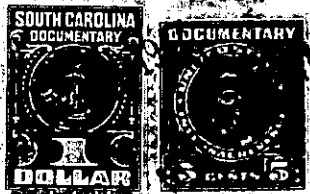

Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of the County Road leading to the P & N Depot, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5 as shown on plat above referred to and running thence along joint line of said lots N. 79-07 E. 172.2 feet to an iron pin in line of property now or formerly owned by Charles Barton; thence with line of his property S. 11-38 E. 25 feet to an iron pin in line of lot No. 4; thence through Lot No. 4, 171 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on east side of said County Road; thence with east side of said County Road N. 13-36 W. 25 feet to the beginning corner.
