AGREEMENT

This Agreement, made this 19th day of November, 1947, by and between Paul D. Karsten, Jr., party of the first part, and Elizabeth LaField Karsten, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH

Whereas, the party of the first part and the party of the second part were heretofore duly married and there have been no issue to such marriage; and

Whereas, differences have arisen between the parties hereto, because of which, they now are, and have for some time past, been living separate and apart from one another, and all attempts at a reconciliation between the parties hereto have failed; and

Whereas, the parties hereto desire to settle and adjust forever, all rights of support and maintenance, property rights, and any and all other rights, claims, or demands arising out of the marriage relationship between the parties hereto; and

Whereas, the party of the second part is fully informed regarding the extent of the estate, income and financial prospects of the party of the first part, and considers the terms of this agreement fair, and she has been fully advised of all of her rights;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration, the parties hereto agree as follows:

First: From and after the date hereof, the parties hereto will continue to live separate and apart from one another, and each party shall be free from the interference, authority, and control, direct or indirect, of the other party, and each may reside at any place he or she desires and may engage in any occupation, employment, and business he or she desires, in all respects as if unmarried.

Second: Upon the execution of this agreement, the party of the first part will pay to the party of the second part the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00)
