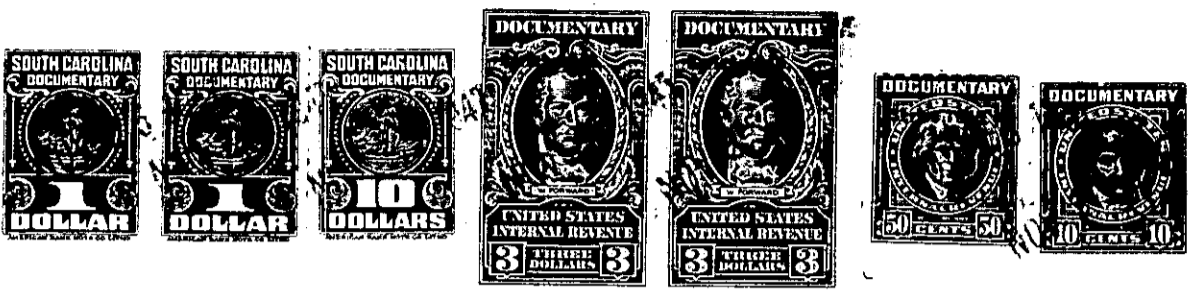

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being a part of the sub-division known as McCullough  
Heights and designated as lot No. 43 of said sub-division as is shown by plat  
of same recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E"  
at page 95, reference being craved to said plat for a more particular description.  
Said lot has a frontage of 61.6 feet on Donnybrook Street and runs back in  
parallel lines 171 feet, more or less.

This conveyance is subject to the building conditions and sanitary regulations  
and restrictions set forth in the deed of the Colonial Company to Jos. A. McCullough  
dated April 28, 1913, recorded in said office in Deed Book 25 at page 4.
