All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and
being in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South
Carolina, on the north side of Sulphur Springs Road, and being known
and designated as lot No. 14 of the property of Annie N. Stansell
upon a plat thereof prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, 1947, record-
ed in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat book P at
page 99, and having according to said plat the following metes and
bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Sulphur Springs
Road, the joint corner of lots Nos. 14 and 15; and running thence
with the joint line of said lots N. 2-30 W. 177.5 ft. to an iron pin,
the rear joint corner of said lots; thence N. 88-30 E. 50 ft. to an
iron pin the rear joint corner of lots Nos. 13 & 14; thence with the
joint line of said lots S. 2-30 E. 176.6 ft. to an iron pin on the
north side of said road; thence with the north side of said road
S. 87-30 W. 50 ft. to the beginning corner.
