to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

William S. H. Piper and Ruth M. Piper, their heirs and assigns

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

On the Northwest side of Super Highway, No. 29, about one mile from the corporate limits of the City of Greenville and being known and designated as Lot No. 14 on plat of property of grantor known as University Park, made by Dalton and Neves in November, 1946 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book P at page 127 and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the right of way of Super Highway No. 29 at the joint front corner of lot nos. 14 and 15 and running thence with the line of lot #15 N. 37-34 W. 190 feet to an iron pin on a 20 foot alley at the joint rear corner of lot nos. 14 and 15; thence with said alley N. 52-26 E. 100 feet to the joint rear corner of lot nos. 13 and 14; thence with the line of lot no. 13 S. 37-34 E. 190 feet to the joint front corner of lot no. 13 and 14 on the right of way of said Super Highway; thence with said Highway S. 52-26 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
