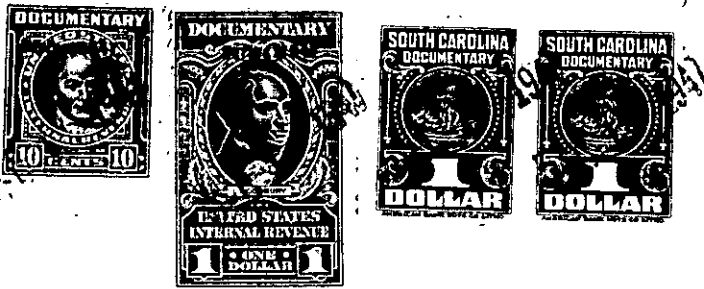

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, on the west side of the White Horse Road, known and designated as lot # 5 of the nos. 1, Goldsmith subdivision as shown by plat made by W. J. Middle, June 1944, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in plat book "C" at page 41, and according to said plat, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the middle of the White Horse Road corner of lot # 6 shown on said plat, and running thence along line of lot # 6, S. 61-75 W. 356.8 feet to iron pin at rear line of lot # 9 shown on said plat; thence S. 40-00 W. 198.6 feet to iron pin at rear corner of lot # 4; thence along line of lot # 4 W. 61-55 N. 310.7 feet to point in middle of White Horse Road; thence along middle of said road N. 20-00 W. 120 feet to the point of beginning.
