all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, at the intersection  
of Buncombe, Richardson and West North Streets, and having the  
following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at the southwest corner of the intersection  
of West North and Richardson Streets and running thence with  
North Street, S. 69-07 E. 49.95 feet to an iron pin; thence  
S. 20-04 W. 81.7 feet to an iron pin on Buncombe Street;  
thence with Buncombe Street, N. 34-30 W. 60.19 feet to an  
iron pin on Richardson Street; thence with Richardson Street  
N. 18-57 E. 47.45 feet to the beginning.
