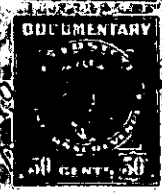
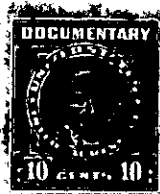

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as lot number 2 of the
subdivision known as Highview Acres a Plat of which is of record in the R.M.C.
Office of Greenville County in Plat Book 0, at Page 123, and having the following
metes and bounds to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the North side of the Sulphur Springs Road, the joint
front corner of Lots 1 and 2 of said subdivision, and running thence N. 3-00 W.
500 ft. to a point; thence S. 87-00 W. 140 ft. to a point; thence S. 3-00 E. 500 ft.
