HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said John P. Williams

"All the right, title and interest of the minor Plaintiffs,
June E. Sauls, C. Rodney Sauls, Jimmy W. Sauls and Carol Ann Sauls,
in and to the following described real estate:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about four miles from
Greenville Court House, near the Easley Bridge Road and Dunham's Bridge
Road, and being a part of the S. T. Earle lands and having the follow-
ing metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a sycamore tree on a branch and running thence N.
27-40 E. 566.5 feet to a road; thence with the said road N. 42 W. 580
feet to a road; thence with the last road S. 38-17 W. 854 feet to a
pin in said road; thence S. 21 E. 398.5 feet to a poplar tree; thence
S. 17-30 E. 275 feet to a branch; thence with the meanders of said
branch 575 feet to the beginning corner and containing 13.69 acres,
more or less."
