Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Mrs. Pauline Bush Shane,
nee: Pauline Bush,

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of - - Ten Dollars & love and affection - - - - ~~Dollars~~

to me paid by Mrs. S. M. Sullivan,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and re-
leased, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. S. M.

Sullivan, her heirs and assigns: All my right title and interest,
same being a one-eighth (1/8) interest, in and to:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, about 2 1/2 miles from Greenville Court House, in a neighbor-
hood known as Freetown, being Lot No. 4 of the Newton Garrison land,
beginning on an alley ten feet wide at the corner of Lot 3 and running
thence with the alley S. 14 W. 30 feet, thence N. 84 W. 144 feet to
Vicky Scott's line; thence N. 14 E. 28 1/2 feet to corner of Lot 3 on Vicky
Scott's line; thence S. 8 E. 144 feet to beginning corner on the alley.

ALSO that other lot of land in township, county and state
aforesaid, about 2 1/2 miles from Greenville Courthouse, in a neighborhood
known as Freetown, being a portion of Lot No. 5 of the Newton Garrison
land, said lot beginning at a pin on a ten-foot alley at corner of Lot
No. 4, which was conveyed by Newton Garrison to Henry Austin, and running
thence with Henry Austin line N. 87-30 W. 144 feet to pin in State
Highway leading from Greenville to Pickins; thence with said Highway
S. 75-15 E. 154.6 feet, more or less, to pin in said ten-foot alley; thence
with said ten-foot alley 30 feet, more or less, to beginning corner.
The portion of Lot No. 5 hereby conveyed is a triangle lying between
said Lot No. 4 and the said State Highway and is all of Lot No. 5 that
was not taken by the said State Highway to be used for highway purposes.

The above one-eighth (1/8) undivided interest in and to
the above described property was inherited by me from my mother, Mrs.
L. C. E. Bush who died intestate in Greenville County, South Carolina
on September 27, 1947. The above described land is my interest in the
same conveyed to Mrs. L. C. E. Bush and Mrs. S. M. Sullivan by deed of
Agnes O. Batson dated January 5, 1932 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office
for Greenville County, in Deed Book Vol. 163 at page 129.
