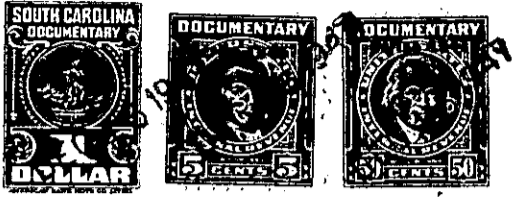

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ben H. Bishop, his Heirs and ...  
Assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, about one mile north from Chick Springs,  
lying on the east side of the Rutherford Road, and on the northern  
side of the Old Chick Springs Road, and being a part of the same  
land that was conveyed to me by deed from John E. Broadnax April  
12th, 1946, and having the following courses and distances, to wit :-

Beginning on an iron pin on the southern bank of the Old  
Chick Springs Road, Mike Miller's corner, and runs thence with the  
line of property formerly known as the Hardy Wright tract and more  
recently as the Henry F. Payne tract, N. 18-05 E. 189.3 feet to an  
iron pin on the said line; thence a new line N. 85-00 W. 314 feet  
to a point in the center of the Rutherford Road (iron pin back on  
line at 17 feet); thence with the center of the said road S. 5-00 W.  
227 feet to a point in the said road and on the Mike Miller line;  
thence with the said line N. 86-00 E. 274.5 feet to the beginning  
corner, and containing One and Thirty Seven One-hundredths (1.37)  
acres, more or less.
