in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jack Benjamin Whisnant, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the South side of North Franklin Road, and being known and designated as the northeastern portion of Lot No. 6 of the property of Olive C. Dill, et al., as shown on plat thereof made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor on April 4th, 1946, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of North Franklin Road at the corner of Lot No. 7, which point is 421.6 feet Northwest of the center of the bridge over Langston Creek, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 7, S. 1-30 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 81-10 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 1-30 W. 200 feet to an iron pin in the center of said North Franklin Road; thence along the center of said North Franklin Road, S. 81-10 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.
