

expenses and necessary incidentals which a boy or a girl may incur in acquiring an education as above provided. It is my desire that my trustee shall use sound business judgment and discretion in paying out all of the necessary funds so that each of my grandchildren may receive an education as above set forth.

5. Should any of my grandchildren, including those now living and those that may hereafter be born, die leaving a child or children, then such great grandchild or great grandchildren shall be entitled to receive the parent's share for his or her education.

6. At the present time, my son, R. E. Houston, Jr., is the father of two children, and my son, I. H. Houston, is the father of four children. The distribution of the income as herein provided shall be on a per stirpes basis; that is to say, one-half of the net income to the lineal descendants of R. E. Houston, Jr. and one-half of the net income to the lineal descendants of I. H. Houston.

7. In trust to make final distribution of the corpus and any remaining income within 20 years after the death of my last grandchild now living, but my trustees or trustee shall have the power and authority to make a final distribution at any time after 50 years from the date hereof. At the time of the final distribution, there shall be distributed the remaining corpus and any accrued income to each of my grandchildren per stirpes; that is to say, one-half to the children of R. E. Houston, Jr. and one-half to the children of I. H. Houston. Should one or more of my grandchildren, at the time of the final distribution, be then deceased, leaving a child or children, such great grandchild or great grandchildren shall receive the parent's share.

8. Should, at any time, there be no lineal descendants of one of my sons, then the lineal descendants surviving of my other son shall be entitled to the entire benefits of this trust.

And I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said grantees hereinabove named, their successors and assigns
