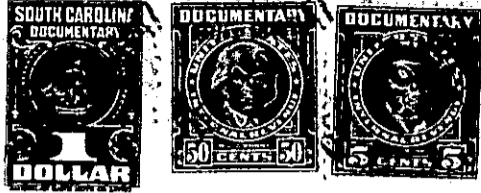

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about one mile east from Oneal, lying south from the road that leads from O'Neal to Mt. Lebanon Church, and on the south side of the road that leads from the above named road to my home, being bounded on the north and east by other lands of myself, on the south by lands now or formerly of Enoch Howell, and on the west by lands now or formerly of Lon Beacham, and being a part of the same land that was conveyed to me by deed from J. T. Taylor October 23rd 1922 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 88 at page 34, and having the following courses and distances, to wit :-

Beginning on an iron pin on the Beacham line and joint corner of the Howell tract, and runs thence with the Beacham line N. 3-30 E. 568 feet to an iron pin on the south edge of the road that leads to my home; thence with the said road S. 68-15 E. 100 feet to a bend in the road; thence S. 53-15 E. 136 feet to an iron pin in the said road; thence S. 3-30 W. 466 feet to an iron pin on the Howell line; thence with the Howell line N. 86-20 W. 208.6 feet to the beginning corner, and containing Two and Forty Eight One-hundredths (2.48) acres, more or less.
