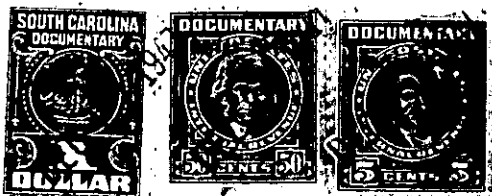

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
does grant, bargain, sell and release unto **WILLIAM L. BROOME, his Heirs and Assigns,**
forever:

All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being on the Northern side of Crane Avenue,
near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as
Lot No. 42 on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-
ville County in Plat Book M, at page 39, and having, according
to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of
Crane Avenue, at the joint front corner of Lots No. 42 and 43,
and running thence along the common line of said lots, N. 7-52 E.
215.6 feet; thence N. 72-23 W. 101.5 feet to an iron pin at the
joint rear corner of Lots No. 41 and 42, and running thence
along the common line of said last mentioned lots, S. 7-52 W.
232.8 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Crane Avenue;
thence along the Northern side of Crane Avenue, S. 82-08 E. 100
feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

The property herein conveyed is subject to the re-

for Greenville County in Deeds Volume 243, at page 146, refer-
ence to which is hereby made.
