Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of the White Horse Rd at the corner of lots Nos 23 and 24, and running thence N. 9-16 E. 53-1/3 ft to a new corner on the east side of White Horse Rd; thence a new line S. 80-44 E. 200 ft to an iron pin, a new corner in the adjoining line of lots Nos. 23 and 46; thence S. 9-16 W. 53-1/3 ft to an iron pin and corner; thence N. 80-44 W. in the joining line of lots Nos. 23 and 24 200 ft to an iron pin in the east side of the White Horse Rd, the point of beginning. This being the southeast portion of lot No. 23.
