Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Brookside Way at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 167, and 168 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 167, N. 23-48 W. 288.2 feet to an iron pin on the line of a ten foot reservation for pipes and poles; thence along said reservation S. 66-12 W. 75 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 170 and 171; thence along the line of Lot 171, S. 23-48 E. 289.3 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Brookside Way; thence along said Brookside Way, N. 66-12 E. 50 feet to a point; thence N. 63-49 E. 25 feet to the point of beginning.
