(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Greer Milling Company, a Corporation, its
successors and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greer, lying on the Northwest
side of Littlefield Street, being all of Lot No. 25 and one-half
of Lot No. 26 on plat of property of the Maida Westmoreland and
W. T. Walker property, which plat is on record in the RMC Office
for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a point on the West edge of Littlefield Street,
being the center of line of Lot No. 26 and being exactly fifteen feet
from the Northeast corner of the William Tolliver Bramlett home lot,
and runs thence with the Western edge of said Littlefield Street
N. 32.10 E. 39 feet to a stake, the common corner of Lots 24 and 25;
thence with the common line of these lots N. 57.17 W. 125 feet to a
stake, joint corner of Lots 20, 21, 24 and 25; thence S. 32.10 W.
39 feet to a point, being the center of dividing line between Lots
22 and 26; thence along the center line of Lot No, 26 S. 57.17 E. 125
feet to the beginning.
