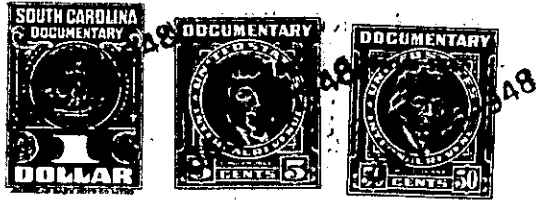

Two Hundred & No/100 ( \$ 200.00 ) Dollars  
to Me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by William C Jones  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William C Jones

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds,  
" Beginning at stone on Pine Avenue 2.70 chains from the corner  
of Pine Avenue and road leading to Pelzer, South Carolina, and  
tunning thence S-20-3/4 W - 7.75 chains to a stone ; thence S-86-W  
4.00 chains to a stone ; thence N- 20-3/4- E 7.75 chains to a stone  
on Pine Avenue ; thence with Pine Avenue N- 86 - 4.00 chains to  
the point of beginning, containing Three and five one-hundreth  
( 3-5/100 ) acres more or less and known as lot No.26 on a plat  
of Arden made by Jno. M. Cureton D.S. November 10th 1906."
