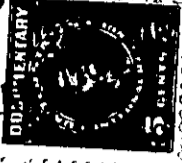

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, W. M. Batson, of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Fifty-Five Hundred and No/100 - - - - - Dollars
to me paid by E. E. Goss

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said E. E. Goss, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Western side of Selma Street, near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 41 on Plat of property of Edgar C. Waldrop, made by Dalton & Neves in March, 1946, recorded in Plat Book B at page 171, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Western side of Selma Street, 328.5 feet South from Fair Street, at corner of Lot No. 40, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 86-04 W. 150 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 58; thence with the line of said lot, S. 3-56 E. 50 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 42; thence with the line of said lot, N. 86-04 E. 150 feet to a stake on Selma Street; thence with the Western side of Selma Street, N. 3-56 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

The grantee is to pay taxes for the year 1948.
