to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by George Allen and Ellen G. Allen, likewise of Greenville county, S. C., (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

George Allen and Ellen G. Allen, their heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Ward six (6) of the City of Greenville, and being shown as Lot No. 39 of section 3, on page 95, on the City Block Book of Greenville, South Carolina, said lot being located on the West side of Wilkins Alley, and having, according to plat of Dalton & Neves, Engineers, dated Sept. 2nd, 1947, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in Wilkins Alley, and running thence along the South side of property now or formerly belonging to Mauldin N. 76-00 W seventy and eight-tenths (70.8) feet to an iron pin on line of City School property; thence along the line of City School property S. 9-30 W. one hundred and fifty-six (156) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 70-23 E. seventy-one (71) feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-20 W. one hundred and fifty-four (154) feet down the center of Wilkins Alley to an iron pin in Wilkins Alley, the beginning corner.
