on the East side of Franklin Street Extension, at the corner of  
property now or formerly belonging to the Estate of J. O. Hightower,  
and runs thence along said Franklin Street Extension in a northerly  
direction sixty and one-fourth (60 $\frac{1}{4}$ ) feet, more or less, to a stake  
on the eastern side of said Franklin Street Extension at corner of
