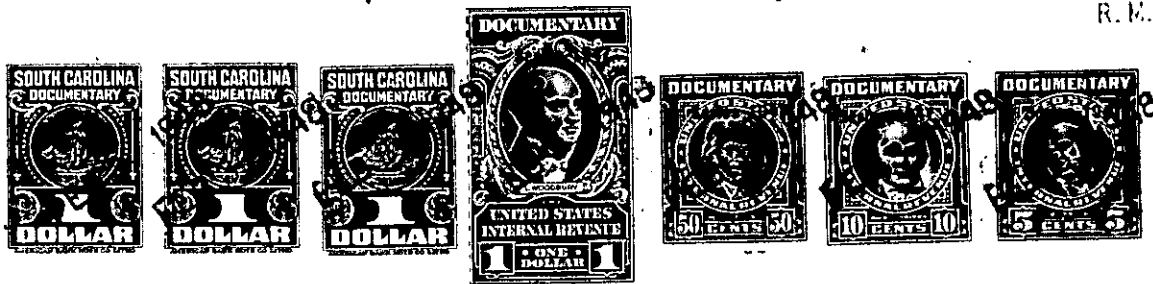

by H. M. Hollifield and Ruth Hollifield

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. M. Hollifield and Ruth Hollifield

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O Neal Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina lying on the south side of the Old State Road
and lying on the north side of a road known as W.S. Dill road and bounded
on the west by lands of J. Carlton and land of Grantee and on the east by
land of Grantor and containing Four and 77/100 Acres, more or less, with
Metes and Bounds as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin, a corner on J. Carlton's line and
corner between Grantor and Terry T. Dill lands and on the north side of
road, and running thence N. 66-30 E. 842 feet to iron pin on Grantee's
land, thence S 41-30 E. 72 feet to iron pin; thence N66-30 E. 510
feet to corner on south side of the Old State Road; thence S 46-15 E.
186 feet to iron pin; thence S. 43-45 W. 230 feet to iron pin; thence
N. 46- 15 W. to stake; thence S72-22 W. 645 feet to stake by a double
White Oak; thence S 44-05 W. 254 feet to point in center of road;
thence with road as line N 76-30 W. 394.2 feet to beginning.
