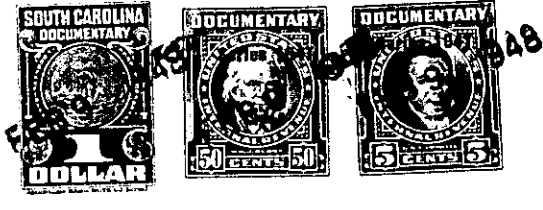

County, State of South Carolina, at chick Springs, on the north side of
Highland Avenue, being bounded on the north by lands of B. F. Flynn
Estate, on the east by lands of C. E. Miller, on the south by the
said Avenue and lands of myself and on the west by lands of myself,
and being a part of the same land that was conveyed to me by deed
from B. A. Morgan November 2nd 1925, and having the following cour-
