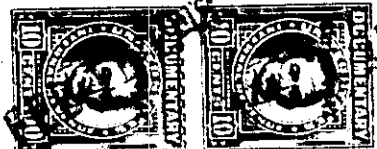

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 2, Block
"C" of Highland Terrace and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point north side of Hillcrest Drive, joint southern
corner of Lot Nos. 2 and 3, running thence along dividing line of
said lots N. 22-57 E. 190 feet to a point joint northern corner of
said lots: thence along rear line of Lot No. 2, N. 67-03 W. 71 feet
to point, joint northern corner of Lots No. 1 and 2; thence along
