presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said.....

R. F. Craigo, his heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being in Graceland Cemetery, and
being known and designated as Lot No. four hundred and sixty-two (462), in Section
No. eight (8) of said Graceland Cemetery, containing two hundred (200) square
feet, more or less,; and being more fully described as per Map on file in the
Office of said Greenville Cemetery Association; and being one of the lots conveyed
to E. D. Childs by Greenville Cemetery Association by deed dated May 20th, 1915,
and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in
Deed Book No. 29, at page 316. This deed is executed, however, subject to the
Rules, Regulations and Conditions as are shown in the deed hereinabove referred
to made to the said E. D. Childs.
