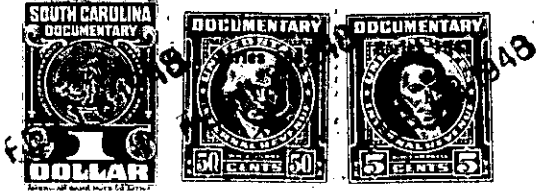

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said..... Terry J. Goldsmith

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina and having the following metes and bounds to wit;

Known as the land last owned by H. L. Goldsmith, now deceased, Adjoining land  
of Nancy Martin, S. M. Goldsmith, John H. Childs, James Brookshire and Hollis  
Peterson, Beginning on a stake on fork of Branch, thence running N. 22 1/2 E.  
23.68 to a stone, Peterson Corner, thence S. 52 E. 445 to a Stone, thence S. 26 1/2  
W. 950 to a Poplar, S. 24 W 317 Bend, S. 12 W. 545 to a Stake, thence S. 15 E 250  
to a Persimmon, in fork of Branch, thence S. 62 W. 475 to a Bend, in Branch  
thence N. 55 1/2 W. 450 to the beginning corner, and containing Thirteen Acres,
