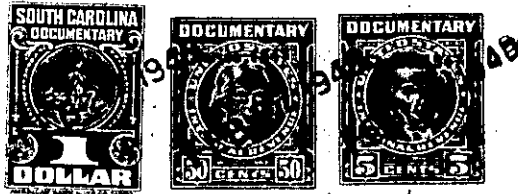

Brockman, Surveyor, June 22, 1935, and having the following courses  
and distances to wit:
