

thing whatsoever in and relating to the said service station business; that each partner shall have free and full access thereto at all times, but shall not remove the same from the premises of the service station.

(5.) That the business of the service station shall be carried on in the name of Orr and Lankford.

(6.) That no partner shall, without the previous consent in writing of the other partners, assign his share or interest in the partnership except to one or both of the present partners.

(7.) No partner shall do, or willingly suffer to be done, anything whereby, or by means thereof, the stock and trade, capital or property of the partnership may be attached or taken on execution.

(8.) That no partner shall buy, order or contract for any articles exceeding the value of \$100.00, without the previous consent in writing of the other partners, and in case he does so the other partners shall have the option without recourse to law to take the goods or articles so bought, ordered or contracted for, on behalf of the partnership or to leave the same for the separate use of the partner so buying, ordering or contracting, to be paid for out of his money.

(9.) In all cases relating to the management of the partnership business, the decision of the majority in value of the parties, shall be conclusive and binding on all the partners.

(10.) That the partners are mutually agreed that G. H. Orr shall act as manager of the service station and, subject to the terms of this agreement with the right to hire and discharge employees and to use his discretion in conducting said business.

(11.) That it is mutually agreed by and among the parties hereto that all partnership funds shall first be applied to the payment of any debts and lawful liabilities incurred by said partnership and that any net profit derived after payment of all debts shall belong to the said parties in equal shares; PROVIDED, that the capital advanced shall remain undiminished.

(12.) That the parties have mutually agreed that neither shall lend, spend, give or make away with any part of the partnership property or
