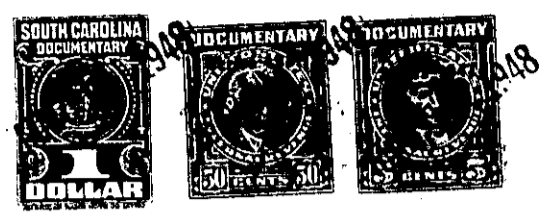

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That ... I, Falbia C. Murrell,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by John W. Ray, Evelyn M. Ray, Fred E. Moseley and Louise D. Moseley
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said John W. Ray, Evelyn M. Ray, Fred E.
Moseley and Louise D. Moseley, their heirs and assigns, forever:

All that certain, piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying
and being on the North side of High Valley Boulevard in Gantt Town-
ship, Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot 18 on plat of
Fresh Meadow Farms made by M. H. Woodward, Engineer, May 21, 1945,
recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in
Plat Book M, page 127, and having according to said plat the follow-
ing metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of High Valley Boule-
vard, at joint front corner of Lots 17 and 18, and running thence
with the line of Lot 17, N. 8-37 E. 250 feet to an iron pin; thence
S. 81-23 E. 87 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 19,
S. 8-37 W. 250 feet to an iron pin on the North side of High Valley
Boulevard; thence with the North side of High Valley Boulevard,
N. 81-23 W. 87 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to me by deed of L. A. Mose-
ley and C. Henry Branyon dated September 10, 1946 recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 299, at
page 17, and said property is subject to the building restrictions
referred to therein.

The Grantees are to pay 1948 taxes.
