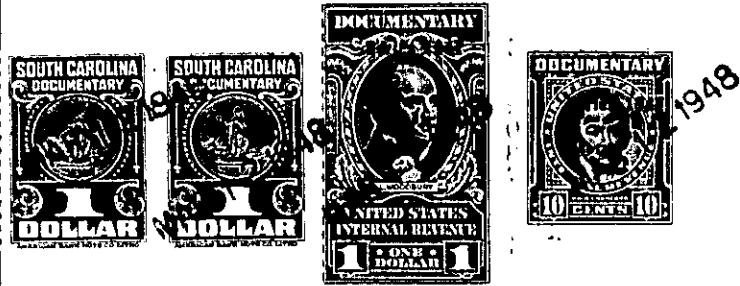

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Raford H. Hall and Mary...
T. Cox,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand & no/100 - - - - -

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Bertie Bishop

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bertie Bishop, his heirs and assigns,
forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, ly-
ing and being on the East side of Bleckley Avenue near the City of
Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, be-
ing shown as Lots 16 and 17 of Block B on plat of Fair Heights made
by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, October 1924, recorded in the R. M. C.
Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book F, pages 256 and
257, and having according to said plat the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Bleckley Avenue
at joint front corner of Lots 15 and 16 of Block B, said pin being
150 feet North from the Northeast corner of the intersection of
Bleckley Avenue and Hanover Street, and running thence along the
line of Lot 15, S. 58-40 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-
20 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 18, N.
58-40 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Bleckley Avenue;
thence along the East side of Bleckley Avenue, S. 31-20 W. 100 feet
to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of that property conveyed to us by deed of
C. C. Bruce, as Trustee, dated February 20, 1947, recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 308, page
70.

The Grantee is to pay 1948 taxes.
