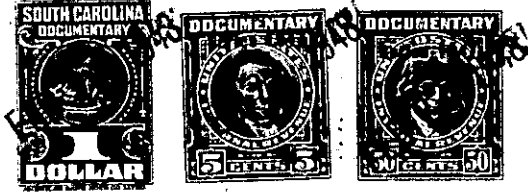

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying on the North side of James Street and  
the East side of Augusta Street, near the limits of the Town of  
Greer, described as Lot No. 8 on plat of the property of Mrs. E. A.  
Wood Estate by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated June 22, 1935, and  
having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of said streets
