

Poole (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said . D. . . C. . . Poole, and . his. Heirs and. Assigns forever,

Greenville Township, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal County, State of South Carolina, lying on the West side of the road that leads from the Gap Creek Road by the old Bart Pennington Place, about seven miles North from the City of Greer, bounded on the North by lands of D. C. Poole, on the East by said road, and lands of T. M. Crain, on the South by lands of Arthur Lynn, and on the West by lands of Tea Barton and Arthur Lynn, containing 4.67 acres, more or less, and being all of that land conveyed to Grantor T. H.
