SEPARATION AGREEMENT

This contract and agreement made and entered into this 21st. day of April, 1947, by and between C. A. Callahan, hereinafter referred to as Party of the First Part, and Mrs. Helen Hughes Callahan, hereinafter referred to as Party of the Second Part, both residents of the County and State aforesaid,

W-I-T-N-E-S-S-E-T-H:

That whereas, the parties are husband and wife, having entered into the marital relationship on the 29th. day of June, 1946, and lived together for some time thereafter as husband and wife, and

Whereas, certain differences have arisen between the parties, and do now exist, which convince them that it is to their best interest, happiness and welfare that they live separate and apart from each other, and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars paid by the Party of the First Part unto Party of the Second Part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the covenants herein contained, do enter into this Separation Agreement and bind themselves by the terms and conditions of same.

It is agreed by and between the parties hereto that they shall live separate and apart hereafter as though no marital relationship was ever entered into between them, and agree and bind themselves not to molest or interfere with the social, business or financial affairs of the other in any way. It is further understood and made a part of this Agreement that the Party of the First Part hereby releases Party of the Second Part from any and all obligations and duties of a wife, and hereby releases any and all interest that he may have in and to any and all property now owned by Party of the Second Part, and in and to all property that she may hereafter acquire.
