

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Tally Street, (formerly Pickney Street) corner of lot No. 18, and running thence along the line of said lot S.  $2l\frac{1}{2}$  W. 95 feet to an iron pin in line of said lot; thence N.  $68\frac{1}{2}$  W. 50 ft: to an iron pin at the rear corner of lot heretofore conveyed to J. B.
