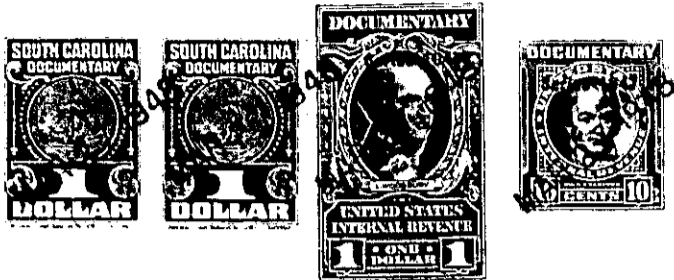

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said WILLIAM H. BRIGHT

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as lot number  
21 of a subdivision known as Highview Acres, a Plat of which is  
of record in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat  
Book "0", at Page 123, and having the following metes and bounds  
to wit:

Beginning at a point on the West side of Courtland Drive  
the joint front corner of lots number 21 and 22, said  
beginning point being 705.6 ft. North of the Northwest  
intersection of Sulphur Springs Road and Courtland Drive,  
and running thence N. 84-30 W. 607 ft. to a point; thence  
N. 6-47 W. 204.7 ft. to a point; thence S. 84-30 E. 650.5  
ft. to a point on the West side of Courtland Drive; thence  
with the West side of Courtland Drive S. 5-30 W. 200 ft.  
to the point of beginning, containing 2.88 acres more or
