

WHEREAS, Ingleside Association by amendment of charter, dated August 16, 1943, changed the name of said corporation to "The Martha Davenport Home", as is shown by amendment of charter recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County on August 17, 1943, recorded in Deed Book 175, Page 122; and

WHEREAS, the grantors in the aforesaid deed desire to release said property from the condition hereinabove set forth so that The Martha Davenport Home will have a good, marketable, fee simple title to the property described in said deed, free of liens, encumbrances, restrictions and conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, Constance Davenport Dooly, Malcolm C. Davenport, Luther M. Davenport, Martha Davenport Josephy (formerly Martha Davenport McCleery), in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar paid by The Martha Davenport Home, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby release and forever discharge the property conveyed by us to Ingleside Association, now The Martha Davenport Home, by deed dated August 21, 1937, and recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance, Greenville County, in Deed Book 200, Page 57; and

We do hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto The Martha Davenport Home all our right, title and interest in and to said property by reason of the insertion or inclusion of the agreement and condition hereinabove set forth in said deed from us to Ingleside Association, now The Martha Davenport Home, so that The Martha Davenport Home shall have a good, marketable, fee simple title to the property therein described as if said agreement and condition had never been inserted in said deed.
