KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Stonewall Mosteller

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and no/100.....

to.....me.....in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Stewart M. Howard and Letha Mae Howard.....  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Stewart M. Howard and Letha Mae  
Howard, and their Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying on the East side of the Greer-Landrums  
Highway (State Highway No. 14), about 2 1/2 miles North from Greer, being  
all of lot No. 2 on a plat of property made for Ervin Forrester by  
H.S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated May 24, 1939, and having the following  
courses and distances:

Beginning at a point in the center of the Greer-Landrums Highway, the  
southwestern corner of said lot, and runs thence N. 76.30 E. 383 feet  
to the center of an abandoned road; thence N. 27.57 W. 169 feet to  
stake, corner of lot No. 3; thence N. 87.38 E. 287 feet to the center  
of the Greer-Landrums Highway; thence along the center of said highway  
S. 2.30 W. 185 feet to a point in road; thence S. 1.30 E. 65 feet to  
the beginning corner, containing 1.6 acres, more or less.

While the above mentioned plat designates the property as owned  
Ervin Forrester, said Ervin Forrester has never owned an interest in  
same.
